### **Orana Joint Organisation of Councils sets its strategic vision for the future**

A four year plan for the Orana Joint Organisation (JO) region was recently adopted by the Orana JO Board.

Orana JO Chair Clr Doug Batten said the 2019-2022 plan sets out the strategies and actions that are planned for the next 4 years, it outlines how the Orana JO will focus on the highest priorities for the region. These being i) a connected region, ii) a vibrant region, iii) an environmentally sustainable region and iv) a capable and collaborative Joint Organisation.

These key priorities have been developed through feedback and consultation with the six Orana JO member councils.

In addition to this a review of relevant plans and documents from all levels of government was undertaken to ensure that the Orana JO strategies integrate with and is aligned to the priorities of the NSW State Plan.

Success in achieving our strategies will be dependent on the future collaboration and cooperation between NSW Government and the JO Member Councils, added Clr Batten.
